They had travelled by bike, train, car and walked to discover our stories







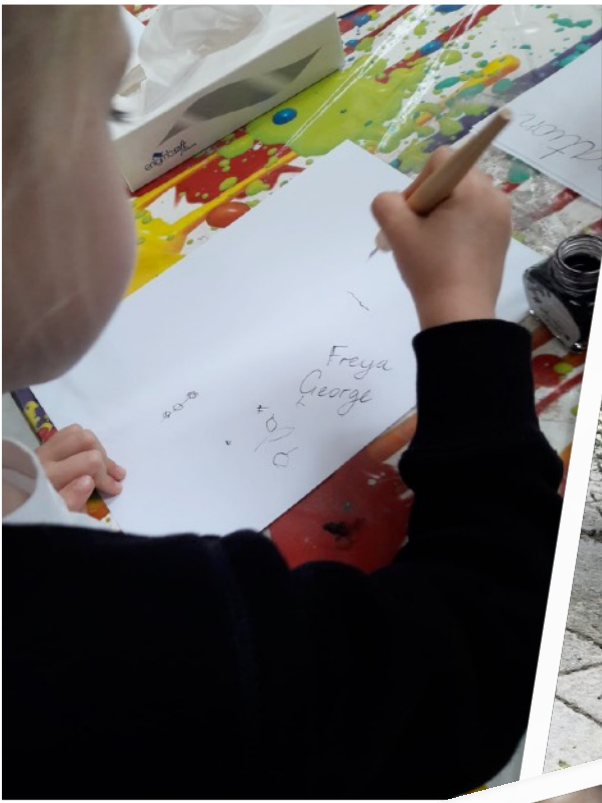
Pat did sterling business at The Heritage Cafe. The Foundation has lovely grounds to enjoy a cup of tea and cakes in ...

Next year promises to be bigger and better ...

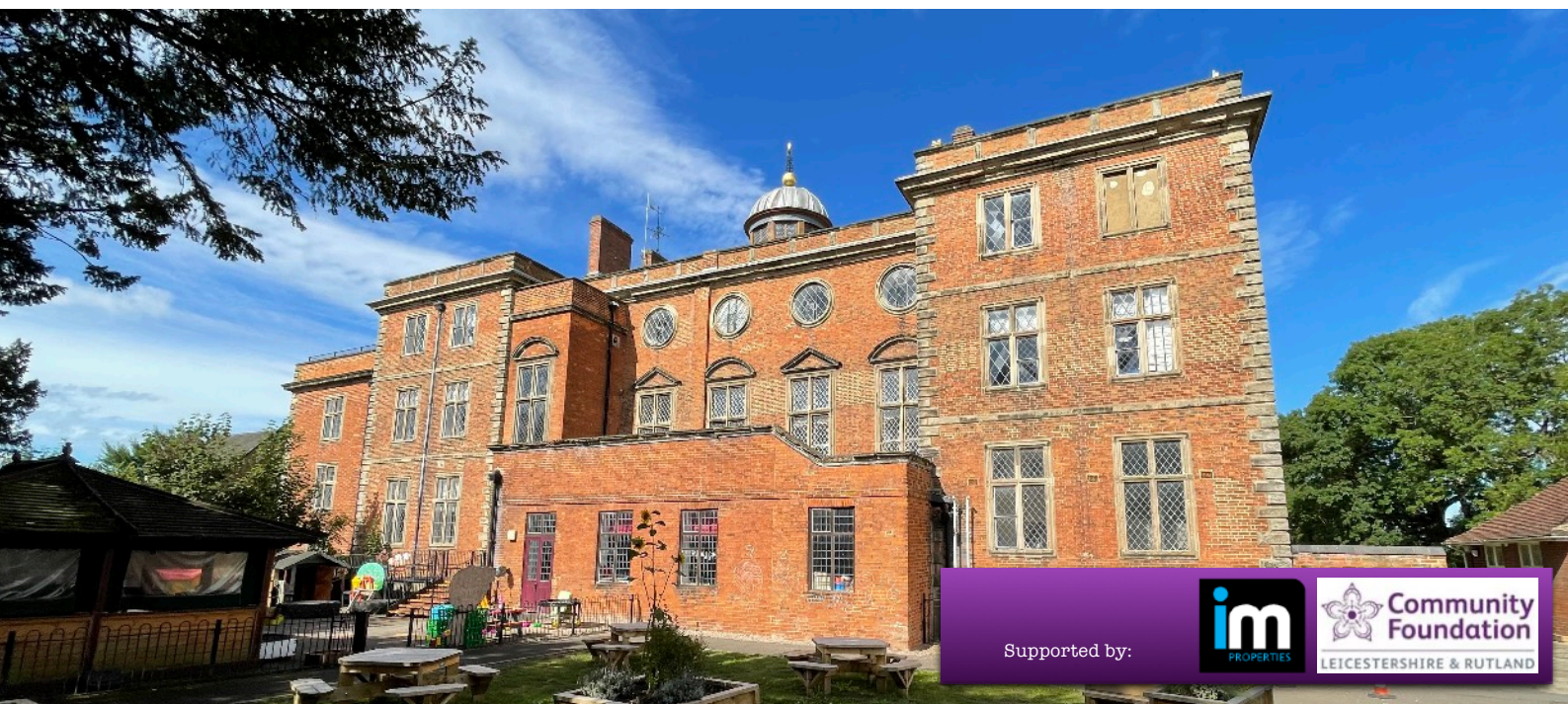
